



PUBLIC NOTICE OF POTENTIAL RECOUNT

NOTICE is hereby given that if the first unofficial election results for the 2019 City of Tampa Municipal Election, reported on Thursday, March 7, 2019, show that a candidate for office would be defeated or eliminated by one-half of one percent or less of the votes cast for such office, a machine recount will be ordered, pursuant to F.S. 102.141.

Additionally, if after a machine recount, the second set of unofficial returns indicates that a candidate for any office was defeated or eliminated by one-quarter of one percent or less of the votes cast for such office, a manual recount shall be conducted.

Any required recounts are tentatively scheduled to begin at **8 a.m. on Friday, March 8, 2019**.

Recounts, if ordered, will occur at the Supervisor of Elections Office, 2514 North Falkenburg Rd. Tampa, FL 33619, and will be open to the public.

Persons are advised that if they decide to appeal decisions made at this recount they will need a record of the proceedings and for such purpose they need to ensure a verbatim record of the proceeding is made, which includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.

Persons with disabilities requiring reasonable accommodations to participate should call the Supervisor of Elections Office at (813) 744-5900, at least 24 hours prior to the meeting.
