

— ARE YOU — READY TO VOTE?

1. Register to vote

If you haven't registered to vote in Florida, visit VoteHillsborough.org and register to vote. You must register no later than 29 days before an election.

2. Update your address

Students may use a college residential address or parent/guardian's address for voter registration. Visit VoteHillsborough.org or call (813) 744-5900 to make any changes.

Vote By Mail

Request Vote By Mail — the most convenient way to vote! The ballot will be sent to your mailbox, and must be in the elections office no later than 7 p.m. on Election Day. Visit VoteHillsborough.org or call (813) 612-4180 to sign up.

You can vote at any of the 24 Early Voting locations across Hillsborough County, including Fred B. Karl County Center downtown. Visit VoteHillsborough.org for a full list of locations.

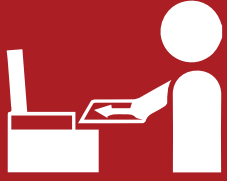
