## Our Primary Focus

three ways to vote

### 1. Vote By Mail by August 28

More than 200,000 Hillsborough County Voters have already signed up to vote by mail for this election. It's not too late for you to take advantage of our most convenient voting method. Visit [VoteHillsborough.org](http://VoteHillsborough.org), call or come by our office to request a mail ballot. We pay the return postage, or drop it in a secure ballot box at any of our offices or Early Voting sites (when they're open).

**Don't forget to seal and sign the envelope!**

### 2. Vote Early August 13 - 26

in person voting

Hillsborough County voters can vote at any of our **19 Early Vote sites** from August 13 - 26. Early Voting sites are open from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Sites are even open on the weekends for added convenience!

### 3. Vote on Election Day August 28

in person voting

August 28 is your **LAST** day to vote, and you must vote in the polling place assigned to your precinct. If you aren't sure where your polling place is, call (813) 744-5900 or visit [VoteHillsborough.org/AreYouReady](http://VoteHillsborough.org/AreYouReady)



## WHAT TO BRING WITH YOU WHEN VOTING IN PERSON

Bring a **current** and **valid** photo and signature ID to the polls. If you don't bring ID, you may vote a provisional ballot. Florida accepts 12 different forms of identification:

- ★ Florida Driver License
- ★ Florida ID Card issued by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles
- ★ U.S. Passport
- ★ Debit or Credit Card
- ★ Military ID
- ★ Student ID
- ★ Retirement Center ID
- ★ Neighborhood Association ID
- ★ Public Assistance ID
- ★ Veteran Health ID (issued by VA)
- ★ Concealed Weapon License (issued pursuant to s. 790.06)
- ★ Government Employee ID

We have added three new voting locations to reduce wait times at our busiest Early Vote sites:

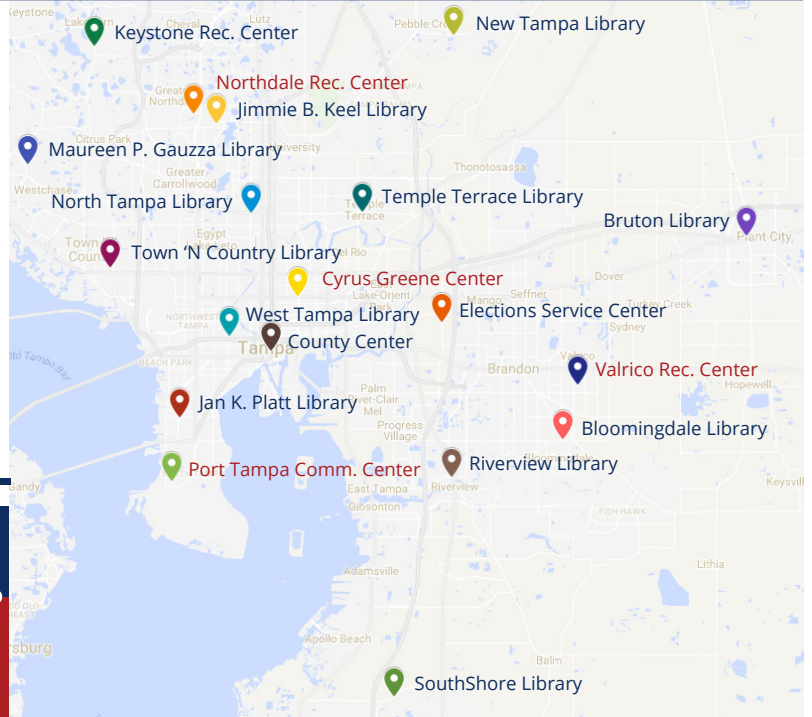
**Northdale Recreation Center**
