**Vote By Mail** Due Aug. 18!

**More than 310,000 Hillsborough County Voters have already signed up for Vote By Mail for the upcoming August Primary.** It's not too late for you to take advantage of the most convenient way to vote! Visit [VoteHillsborough.org](http://VoteHillsborough.org), call or come by our office to request a mail ballot. We pay the return postage, or drop it in a secure ballot box at any of our offices or Early Voting sites (when they're open), we even have a curbside dropoff. Don't forget to seal, sign and date the envelope!



**Early Voting:**  
August 3 — 16, 10 a.m. - 6 p.m.

Hillsborough County voters can vote at any of our 24 Early Vote sites from August 3 - 16, from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. You can even vote on the weekend!



**Election Day:**  
August 18, 7 a.m. - 7 p.m.

**August 18 is your LAST day to vote, and you must vote in the polling place assigned to your precinct.** If you aren't sure where your polling place is, call (813) 744-5900 or visit [VoteHillsborough.org/AreYouReady](http://VoteHillsborough.org/AreYouReady).

## **Safe, In-Person Voting**

Things are going to look a little different, but they won't be unfamiliar. We're encouraging everyone to wear masks, and requiring poll workers and poll watchers to wear them at all times. Only a limited number of people will be allowed inside at one time, to ensure social distancing. Face shields or plexiglass barriers will protect voters and poll workers. And every voter gets their own combination stylus/pen to sign in and mark their ballot. **See for yourself — this short video shows you what to expect.**

# What to bring when voting in person:

Bring a current and valid photo and signature ID to the polls. If you don't bring ID, you may vote a provisional ballot. Florida accepts these forms of photo identification:



- Florida Driver License
- Florida ID Card (*issued by the Dept. of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles*)
- U.S. Passport
- Debit or Credit Card
- Military ID
- Student ID
- Retirement Center ID
- Neighborhood Association ID
- Public Assistance ID
- Veteran Health ID (*issued by VA*)
- Concealed Weapon License (*issued pursuant to s. 790.06*)
- Government Employee ID
