In a typical year, we register or pre-register an average of 3,000 to 3,500 high school students to vote, and we're looking forward to working with students again this semester.

In addition to our outreach efforts, many of you registered to vote when you got your driver license this past year. If you are turning 18 soon and are pre-registered to vote, watch for your Voter Information Card to arrive in the mail around your birthday.



If you are headed off to college this fall and leaving Hillsborough County, you have a choice to make. You can register to vote where you are attending school, or you can keep your registration at home in Hillsborough County and request Vote By Mail ballots.

We are excited to announce our **VoteHillsborough Voter Registration and Art Contest for 2022!**

Historically, we have had students create 8x8" pieces of original artwork to inspire others to have their voices heard and vote. However, it's time to switch things up a bit!

This year, I'm challenging students to create an original "I Voted" sticker for Hillsborough County voters. Once again, our flagship sponsor, Caspers Company McDonald's, is supporting this contest and I'm excited to announce two new sponsors - The Tampa Bay Lightning and Tampa Bay Buccaneers. Their support for this effort to engage our youth is so appreciated!



The first-place winning design will be reproduced as 2"x 2" round stickers and given to voters who vote early or drop off their mail ballot during the two weeks leading up to Election Day for the 2022 Primary and General Elections. We'll also share more sticker designs on hundreds of thousands of bag stuffers distributed by Caspers Company McDonald's restaurants, on our social media channels, in displays at our offices and in other outreach efforts encouraging our community to vote.



For the registration contest, the three schools with the most successful voter registration drives (based on percentage of senior class) will receive a plaque and be recognized in front of the School Board.
