ICYMI: VoteHillsborough Video Series





Qualifying for 2022 Candidates ------



Don't forget – school board and judges are nonpartisan races that everyone votes for during the Primary Election, regardless of party affiliation. Candidate qualifying for judicial candidates took place the last week of April, and we know we will have one race for County Court Judge and two for Circuit Court Judge on the ballot.

The next candidate qualifying period is from noon June 13 until noon June 17, and after that we will know who qualified for other races on the ballot. If you're planning to run for office, we encourage you to beat the rush. The pre-qualifying period starts May 30th.
