### **Are You Ready to Vote?**

We are just a few short weeks away from Election Day for the 2022 General Election. If you haven't yet, now is the time to make your plan to vote and make sure you are #voteready.

## *There Are Three Ways to Vote in Florida*

### **Vote By Mail: Due no later than November 8 at 7 p.m.**



Visit [VoteHillsborough.gov](http://VoteHillsborough.gov), give us a call or swing by one of my four offices to request a Vote By Mail ballot. Once received, mark your ballot, sign the return envelope and drop it in the mail. We pay the return postage! Or, drop it in a secure ballot intake station at any of my offices or Early Voting sites (*when they're open*). **Don't forget to seal, sign and date the envelope.**

*Note: You should allow at least a week for your ballot to reach my office. If you still haven't mailed your ballot back to us by the end of October, I HIGHLY recommend dropping it off in person.*

### **Early Voting: October 24 – November 6, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.**



Pick the time and place that works best for you. Vote at any of the 26 Early Voting sites in Hillsborough County anytime during the Early Voting period (*even on the weekends!*).

Election Day is your LAST chance to vote. On Election Day, you must vote in your assigned polling place. Visit [VoteHillsborough.gov/AreYouReady](http://VoteHillsborough.gov/AreYouReady) to find your polling location or give us a call at (813) 744-5900.

*If you did not request Vote By Mail or an e-mail Sample Ballot, you will be receiving your Sample Ballot in the mail in mid-October. You can use this to help make your decisions before you get to the polls, and I recommend bringing it with you to vote.*
