First 2019 City of Tampa Municipal Election Ballots in the Mail

Tampa, FL - Today, the Hillsborough County Supervisor of Elections sent 825 ballots to absent military and overseas voters, and the office is preparing to send out more than 55,000 ballots to domestic voters next Tuesday, January 29.

Voters who request a Vote By Mail ballot are encouraged to update the signature they have on file with the elections office. Signature updates can be made by filling out an updated voter registration application online or on paper. Online updates add the most recent signature on file with DHSMV to the voter record.

Voters can still request Vote By Mail by visiting VoteHillsborough.org or calling (813) 744-5900. Vote By Mail ballots must be back in the elections office by 7 p.m. on March 5, and the Postal Service recommends that voters mail ballots back at least one week before the deadline. Voters can also drop their ballot off at any of the four Hillsborough County Supervisor of Elections offices (during office hours) or seven Early Voting sites (during Early Voting hours).

The voter registration deadline for this election is February 4th, and only those registered to vote in the City of Tampa may vote in this election. Voters who are already registered to vote in Florida can update their address any time before voting.
